- Encourage children to be reflective, independent learners, who embrace challenges and mistakes as an integral part of learning.
- Utilise flexible, modern, safe and calm learning environments that are matched to individual needs, supporting all learners and enabling child-led learning opportunities.

- Use Learning Ladders to track every child's progress to ensure all children reach their potential by providing support, challenge and engagement for all.
